Qualifications to hold Local office are detailed in the AMFA Constitution, Article XIX, Section 1 B as follows:

To be nominated, a member shall be in good standing, an active or active associate member, attended fifty percent (50%) of regular Local meetings held during the last year or present to the Local Secretary a nominating petition containing signatures (valid as certified by the Local Secretary) of ten percent (10%) of the affected members in good standing in the Local (this petition must be submitted before the end of the regular membership meeting in September), and have been free of all fines and assessments to the National and Local for the preceding twelve months prior to nomination (except for the first election after receiving charter). Members who are unable to attend a meeting because of verified illness, death in the family, vacation, official Association business, or because they reside and work beyond a fifty mile radius of where the meeting is held will be given credit for having attended that meeting for purposes of meeting the minimum attendance requirements.

If you plan to nominate a fellow member, please inform them, so that if they do not meet the eligibility requirements for office they can obtain a nomination petition. Nomination petitions are available on the Local 14 website—go to [www.amfa14.org](http://www.amfa14.org), drag your pointer over the *Forms* tab at the top of the homepage and select the item labeled *AMFA Local 14 Officer Nomination Petition* from the dropdown menu.

Completed forms must be submitted to the Local 14 Secretary before the nomination closing date—which can be found on the Local Nomination Notice. Forms can be submitted in person, by fax or via US mail using the information in the letterhead at the top of this page. Forms can also be submitted electronically by saving a copy to your desktop, completing the form, saving all changes, attaching it to an email and sending it to: [secretary@amfa14.org](mailto:secretary@amfa14.org)
